We ask that contributors adhere to the following guidelines. You may submit your post to publicrelations@harrelsoncenter.org.

## 1. Constructive and Respectful Contributions

- Posts should aim to add value to the nonprofit community, offering ideas, experiences, and constructive criticism in a way that fosters learning and discussion.
- Disagree respectfully, focusing on the issue rather than the individual.
- Content should be free of any form of discrimination, or any language intended to demean others.
- Content that is inappropriate for a general audience will not be accepted.

### 2. Original, Honest and Accountable Content

- Ensure that your content is original or properly attributed. Plagiarism is prohibited.
- Be transparent about any conflicts of interest or sponsored content.
- Take responsibility for your words and actions. If a mistake is made, correct it promptly and transparently.

### 3. Legal Compliance

- Do not post content that violates any laws or infringes on the rights of others, including copyright, trademark, privacy, and intellectual property rights.
- And, please do not link to malware, spam, or other harmful content.

### 4. Privacy and Consent

- Respect the privacy of others. Do not share personal information or images of individuals without their explicit consent.
- Protect your own privacy by being mindful of what you share publicly.
